SHAAN SHAHABUDDIN Seattle Central College Professor of Psychology

Professor Shahabuddin is a Pakistani-American who was born and raised in Houston, Texas. He earned his M.A. in General Psychology from Stephen F. Austin State University and a B.S. in Psychology with a minor in Sociology from Texas A&M University. He teaches introductory to psychology, social psychology, psychology of racism, lifespan psychology, and research methods.

PSYC 100: General Psychology

An introduction to the scientific study of human behavior including research methods, brain and behavior, and cognitive and abnormal psychology. No prior knowledge of psychology is required.

PSYC 245: Social Psychology

This course explores the influence of social settings on self-concept, social cognition, conformity, and more, using research on contemporary issues around identity. No prior knowledge of psychology is required.

Spanish Language

A Spanish Language course (5 credits) is required. All students will take a placement test to determine their appropriate level. The local language professors are accredited through Jacksonville University.
